Academics

Term 1 has been a very hectic term characterised amongst other things by a lot of Workshop, Meetings and a one day industrial action. Teachers doubled efforts to ensure that Curriculum coverage does not suffer despite all situations. All sorts of assessment ranging from baseline, dignostic, informal to formal assessment were given the attention they deserved. We thus managed to record a 100% in learner assessment.

73% of our 1286 learners managed to meet pass requirements for term 1. In simple language they passed term 1 assessment. Overall and Item Analysis as revealed to us that we still have a long way to go in enabling our leaners to reach 100% pass at the end of the academic year.

Despite the hardwork and commitment shown in term 1, it is disturbing to report that we still have learners who are not serious with their schoolwork at this era. One may not expect teachers to force learners to submit tasks, assignments and project.
